King Rd. – Normal Maintenance. Spot ditching needs done. Oiling in some sections.

Reynolds Run Rd. –Normal Maintenance. Spot ditching needs done and some tar buggy work needs done in spots. Oiling in some sections.

Anderson Rd. – Normal Maintenance. Spot ditching needs done.

Hultberg Rd. – Normal Maintenance. Spot ditching needs done. Oiling in some sections.


Peterson Rd. – Tar buggy patching. Normal Maintenance. The crown needs taken down by Bimber's and fix the road from Anderson's to the barn. The tar buggy needs used in spots. Oiling in some sections.

Coal Bed Rd. – Spot ditching need done. The cross pipe needs replaced and some tar buggy work needs done. Oiling in some sections.

Hodge Rd. – Spot ditching needs done and some tar buggy work.
