The Elk Township Supervisors regular scheduled meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Matthew Wallin with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 pm. Present were Supervisors Matthew Wallin, Jonathan Ferrie, Secretary Sherry Moore.

PUBLIC COMMENT: none

ROAD NEWS:

Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase a bucket of gear oil Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes. The air compressor quit working. The road crew ordered two starter condensers to see if that is the problem. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to take the compressor motor to someone if the condensers don't work, to see if it is the motor or something else Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

A ¾ inch ratchet is needed at the township garage. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase a used one from Mike Moore for \$30.00 Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

Truck 1 has multiple warning lights on in the dash. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to take truck 1 to Boyles to see what codes it gives on the warning lights Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.** The license plate on truck 1 needs replaced due to the bolt holes rusting out and it being hard to read. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to have the secretary fill out the paperwork needed to request a new license plate Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

The rear studs broke on truck 2 and the wheel came off so it had to be towed from Roper Hollow Road. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to transfer \$1,266.93 from savings to general fund to cover the towing cost Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.** **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase new studs for both rear tires, a hub, two rims, rear brakes to get it back together Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie found a 2008 International Dump truck online for \$30,000.00. The supervisors would like the secretary to make arrangements for the road crew and supervisor to look at it. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion that if the 2008 International Dump Truck is in good condition to go ahead and purchase it up to \$30,000.00 Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

The shoes that were purchased at JMI fell apart the first time they were used. When JMI was contacted they said they would replace them at no charge after they get in a new shipment of them.

The backhoe was tabled at this time.

There was some discussion on the county aid funding. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to use the \$3,390.00 in County Aid towards the HFRS-2 oil Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

There was some discussion on purchasing gravel & oil for the spring of 2026. The road crew will work on getting figures ready for the next meeting so a RFQ can be sent out.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to sign the stormwater application and the building permit approval paperwork for Frederick Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to pay the bills in the amount \$4,017.17 from the General Fund & \$300.00 from the EMS Fund Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:47pm Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.
