

February 25, 2026

The Elk Township Supervisors regular scheduled meeting was called to order by Chairman Kelly VanCise with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 pm. Present were Supervisors Kelly VanCise, Matthew Wallin, Jonathan Ferrie, Secretary Sherry Moore, Road Laborer Mike Moore (left at 8:05) and resident Kenneth Williams (left at 6:40pm).

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Ken Williams was in attendance to discuss an ambulance bill that he received. The Supervisors explained that the money that the township pays the city for their ambulance to transport a patient is \$300.00 which is to cover the city crews' wages. The city will also bill the patient's insurance for the other expenses. The city doesn't honor any local departments ambulance memberships. The city covers the township for ambulance calls during daytime hours Monday – Friday and any other time when there aren't at least two responders for the ambulance.

**ROAD NEWS:**

The culvert by the Scout camp is frozen. It will need some attention in the spring.

We are still waiting on the invoice from Dyke's Garage for the work that was done on truck 1. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to transfer the total of the invoice from Dyke's, rounded to the nearest dollar out of savings to cover the invoice from Dyke's for truck one Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.** The road crew will call for an appointment to get the lights on the dash looked at.

Fairview Township has a 2008 and a 2009 International truck for sale. The road crew test drove both of them and thought they would be a good fit for the township. They are both automatics, come with a plow and sander, have stainless steel beds. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to offer \$50,000 for the pair but to go up to \$60,000 if they don't take the first offer Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.** **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to transfer the purchase price of the trucks and the notary / transfer fees from savings to the general fund Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.** **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase Elk Township decals for both trucks if purchased Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

There was some discussion about selling the 1990 Ford L 9000 and the 1998 Ford L8000. The supervisors would like the road crew to get an idea on what scrap price would be for the trucks so we can set the reserve for what we would get for scrap price plus \$1,000. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to sell the Ford trucks on Municibid if they accept our offer on the two International trucks Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

The backhoe was tabled at this time.

The road crew took the air compressor motor to a place in Jamestown. They found that the starter switch is bad. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to get the switch fixed Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

**Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to sign the County Aid Resolution to use the funds for HFRS-2 Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

There was discussion on what gravel would be needed this year. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to send out a RFQ to purchase 1000 tons of Type C #8 anti-skid to be opened at the last meeting in March Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion.** The supervisor would like the secretary to check on what needs to happen to purchase millings.

Glade Township donated a Hydraulic broom to us. We will need to purchase brushes for it unless we can transfer the old ones over from our old broom. This will fit the front of the backhoe or could possibly be modified to fit the front of truck 1. The road crew will check it over when they have time.

BUSINESS MEETING:

The minutes & treasurer's report from the regular scheduled Elk Township Supervisors meeting on February 11, 2026 were read and approved. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to accept the February 11, 2026 meeting minutes as written Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

There was discussion on the interview that was held last week. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to hire Brian Kiraly at \$21.00 an hour as long as he passes drug test Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

The zoning permit was read and approved for Frederick.

**Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to pay the bills in the amount \$11,738.87 from the General Fund Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

**Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 pm Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

Correspondences were read with no action taken.
