

March 25, 2026

The Elk Township Supervisors regular scheduled meeting was called to order by Chairman Kelly VanCise with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 pm. Present were Supervisors Kelly VanCise, Jonathan Ferrie, Secretary Sherry Moore and Frewsburg Fire Dept. members Lisa Mendell & Chris Lyon (left at 6:48pm).

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

Members from the Frewsburg Fire Department were in attendance to discuss having their ATV Dice Run go through the township. They would like to travel Reynolds Run, Cable Hollow and Robin Hill Roads. The event would be held on June 20. The supervisors let them know that they would have to check with the State Police about the state roads they will be on. They said that they would be letting the riders out in groups instead of everyone together. They have permission to travel through Pine Grove Township and South Valley. The supervisors said they would like them to check back with them the end of April when they have time to check on a few things.

**ROAD NEWS:**

The road crew have a list of items like, hoses, paint, fittings and such for the new trucks and truck 1. The new trucks only came with one key for each so the road crew is going to get another one made. The road crew has started to fill some potholes. Fairview Township sent over the parts information and the spreader box information for both of the new trucks. A new auger will be needed for next year. The road crew is working on changing lights and plows around from the old truck to the new ones.

Bids were received from Allegheny Aggregate, Jamestown Macadam and IA Construction for the Type C #8.

**Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to accept the bid of \$22.88 a ton for 1000 tons more or less from Allegheny Aggregate Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

Truck 1 hasn't gone to Boyles yet to be fixed.

Still waiting on quotes for the antenna, radios and mushroom shoes for the new trucks.

The old truck 2 needs to be cleaned up and then it is ready to sell. Truck 4 also needs cleaned up and the plow changed then it will be ready to sell too. All the spare parts for the trucks that are being sold will go with the trucks.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie had a list of the sections on each township road that needs to be oiled this year depending on what the oil bid comes in at. **Supervisor Jonathn Ferrie made a motion to go out to bid for 13,000 gallons of HFRS-2 more or less to be opened at the April 22, 2026 meeting Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes. Supervisor Jonahtan Ferrie made a motion to go out to bid for 600 gallons more or less of MC70 for the tar buggy to be opened at the April 22, 2026 meeting Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

There was nothing new to report on trying to use millings.

Some of the loggers contacted the office to see about traveling the roads again. The supervisors said they would like them to continue to stay off the roads for a couple more weeks and then check back.

Motion carried with two votes.**

The supervisors would like the secretary to email a few of the applicants from before to see if they would like to come in for an interview. The Supervisors will post the ad on Facebook again to see if they can get more resumes.

There was some discussion on what the fees should be for the spring clean-up days. Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to have the fees be truck loads \$20.00 and car loads \$10.00, tires and tv's will be at an added cost Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion.

Stormwater applications for Stein and Rulander were read and approved. Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to sign the stormwater applications for Stein and Rulander Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motin carried with two votes.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to pay the bills in the amount \$6,409.41 from the General Fund Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:25pm Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

Correspondences were read with no action taken.
