The Elk Township Supervisors regular scheduled meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Matthew Wallin with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 pm. Present were Supervisors Matthew Wallin, Jonathan Ferrie, Secretary Sherry Moore.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

ROAD NEWS:

The road crew has been working on organizing the garage. They found some old chain that is too big to be used on anything. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to place the chain on Municibid to see if we can sell it Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.** They have everything switched over to the new trucks. The road crew will work on potholes when weather permits. The road crew will look at a plugged sluice pipe on Robin Hill Rd to see if it is something they can dig out.

There was some discussion on using mushroom shoes for the 2008 & 2009 trucks because they are harder and may last longer. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase 4 of them at \$160.00 each Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.** The road crew had to take the 2008 & 2009 to Johnson's Tire to get the lugnuts loosened. The 2008 & 2009 are scheduled to get inspected next Wednesday. The quote for radios and antennas for the 2008 & 2009 was discussed. The road crew will check to see if the old radios are compatible with the new antennas. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to use the old radios if they are compatible with the new trucks and to purchase new antennas for them if the total cost is under \$800.00 Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

All of the spare parts for the 1990 & the 1998 will be sold with the trucks. The road crew will get pictures soon to put them up for sale.

The backhoe thumb was tabled at this time.

Millings were tabled at this time.

The supervisors said that the loggers could go back to hauling on the township roads.

Purchasing a jackhammer was tabled at this time.

Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase a ¾ drive ratchet due to breaking the one they had trying to loosen the lugnuts on the new trucks Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

Two augers are needed, one for truck 1 and one for truck 3. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to purchase an auger for truck 1 and an auger for truck 3 Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

BUSINESS MEETING:

The minutes & treasurer's report from the regular scheduled Elk Township Supervisors meeting on March 25, 2026 were read and approved. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to accept the March 25, 2026 meeting minutes as written Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to hire Jason Schott as a temporary part time road laborer at \$18.00 an hour and to start as soon as he can after he passes his physical and drug test Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

The engineering company measured the space down at the garage for an addition. They are drawing it up two ways, gable style and lean-to style.

Zoning permits for J. Rulander & Stein were read and approved.

There was discussion on the new building inspection compliance form that needs completed before building inspections can begin. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion that the secretary sign the compliance forms if everything has been turned in Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

The EMS Response Plan was looked at but tabled until it can be read over.



