The Elk Township Supervisors regular scheduled meeting was called to order by Chairman Kelly VanCise with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 pm. Present were Supervisors Kelly VanCise, Jonathan Ferrie, Matthew Wallin, Secretary Sherry Moore.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

ROAD NEWS:

The road crew is still ditching and filling pot holes when weather permits. Switching fuel companies was tabled at this time.

If any bids are received for the 1990 Ford Truck they will be opened at the June 10 meeting. If no bids are received, we will have to run the ad again.

The road crew is still waiting on Land Pro to get back to them about coming to service the backhoe. Millings & a jackhammer were tabled at this time.

The road crew found out that they don't have MC70 at the Jamestown plant like they were told and the closest for purchasing it through Suit Kote is at the Meadville plant. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to go to Meadville to purchase MC70 Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

There was some discussion on getting brushes for the broom. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to purchase brushes for the broom from Stephenson's at approximately \$900.00 Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

The radios for trucks 3 & 4 will be installed in June.

BUSINESS MEETING:

The minutes & treasurer's report from the regular scheduled Elk Township Supervisors meeting May 13, 2026 were read and approved. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to accept the May 13, 2026 meeting minutes as written Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

Supervisor Kelly VanCise made a motion to offer Kevin Bilman the full-time position starting at \$21.00 if he passes the physical and drug test Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.

There was some discussion on who owns Hellings Lane. As far as the supervisors know Hellings Lane has never been considered a township road.

Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to sign the Catholic & Mack cemetery agreements with Ryan Fitzsimmons Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.

The check for the scrap metal hasn't been received yet for spring clean-up so the final amounts aren't available yet. We had 22 truckloads and 1 car load.

A zoning permit for Anderson and Wehner were read and approved. Stormwater applications for Harrington, Cofield and Neiswonger were read. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to sign the stormwater applications for Harrington, Cofield and Neiswonger Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

The secretary had quotes from the PSATS health insurance where the township can have one employee on the policy. It was tabled at this time.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to pay the bills in the amount \$6,407.59 from the General Fund Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.

Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:36 pm Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.

Correspondences were read with no action taken.
