ROAD NEWS:

The road crew has been out with the tar buggy filling potholes and will need approximately another 400 gallons to get the roads ready for oiling. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to purchase approximately 400 gallons of MC70 for the tar buggy to finish doing potholes on the township roads. Motion carried with two votes.** Cable Excavating was up today and will be here tomorrow to grade some sections of the township roads. The township added some 2RC today to a few of the graded areas that needed it. Cable Excavating will pack the areas in with the roller when he is finished.

There was no other information on the millings at this time.

The road crew got a couple quotes on a jackhammer. Harbor Freight is \$650.00 and Lowe's is \$1,200.00. This was tabled at this time.

The chains were tabled at this time.

There were no bids received for the 1990 Ford. This is the second time that the truck was advertised with no bids received. The PennDOT Representative also sent it out in a bulk email to other townships. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to sell the 1990 Ford outright for \$3,500.00 or best offer Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.** **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to adopt resolution 5-2026 to sell the 1990 Ford Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to adopt Resolution 5-2026 to sell the 1990 Ford Truck Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

Brush Run Lumber and Wagner Lumber have completed their hauling on the township roads. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to return their bonds Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to return the road bonds to Brush Run Lumber and Wagner Lumber Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.**

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:29 pm Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.
