The Elk Township Supervisors regular scheduled meeting was called to order by Chairman Kelly VanCise with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:30 pm. Present were Supervisors Kelly VanCise, Matthew Wallin (7:20pm- 8:13pm), Jonathan Ferrie, Secretary Sherry Moore, Residents David and Jamie Phelps (left at 6:46pm)

PUBLIC COMMENT: David and Jamie Phelps were in attendance to discuss their stormwater application and to discuss where they could put a pavilion on their property.

ROAD NEWS:

The road crew has been out with the tar buggy filling potholes. They have done Peterson Rd, Hultberg Rd and Robin Hill Rd. Allegheny Aggregates has been delivering skid when they can. The road crew got the brushes on the new broom and fixed it to work on the front of truck 1. They also got the chimney pipe replace at the garage for the wood stove. Enos's are going to fill the tractor tires this week. The fuel company has been switched for the garage. The new company is going to try to put monitors on at least one of the tanks.

Nothing new to report on the backhoe, jackhammer or millings.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to purchase a set of chains for truck 2 and truck 3 Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with two votes.

One of the radios have been installed and the hitch plate has been installed.

BUSINESS MEETING:

The minutes & treasurer's report from the regular scheduled Elk Township Supervisors meeting June 10, 2026 were read and approved. **Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to accept the June 10, 2026 meeting minutes as written Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.**

The new employee Jesse Barber will start full time on June 29, 2026.

We did well with the metal container at the spring cleanup. We received \$1,055.54 for the scrap metal. We had 22 trucks and 1 car come to the cleanup this year.

A stormwater application for Phelps was read and approved. **Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to sign the stormwater application for Phelps Supervisor Kelly VanCise seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.** Zoning permits for GEW Trees and Conklin were read and approved.

Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie made a motion to pay the bills in the amount \$8,170.36 from the General Fund and \$114.86 from the Fire Fund and \$2,527.32 from Liquid Fuels Fund Supervisor Matthew Wallin seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.

Correspondences were read. The addition building plans to the township garage were looked at. They were tabled at this time. The Right to Know request received about the sewage records for three properties in the township and the Right to Know request received for all sewage plans and ordinances from 1972- present were discussed. The secretary has been working with the solicitor on these.

Supervisor Matthew Wallin made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:13 pm Supervisor Jonathan Ferrie seconded the motion. Motion carried with three votes.
